EXERCISE 1. Fill in the missing verbs: (2 points)

FIRST AID: Burns(1)___ the burn down. (2)___ large amounts of water for at least 10 minutes over the burn. Explain what you are doing to the casualty, (3)___ them and make them comfortable.
